## DRS CLIENTS' RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

All clients have the right to request that the Domestic Relations Section provides any or all of the services above. Clients seeking services must cooperate and comply with the Federal requirements and Pennsylvania Court procedures as follows:

- 1. Clients must appear in the Domestic Relations Section upon proper notice when required to do so.
- 2. In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, clients with disabilities may request accommodations for attendance at required DRS appearances by calling the DRS and requesting specific accommodations.
- 3. Clients must provide the information requested by the Court necessary to process the case.
- Clients must report to the Domestic Relations Section, in writing, within seven (7) days, any change of address, employment and any other information requested by the Court.
- 5. Clients have the right to periodic review of the support order.
- 6. Acceptance of Public Assistance operates as an assignment of support to the PA Department of Public Welfare. Support payments on behalf of clients or their children who receive welfare will be paid to the PA Department of Public Welfare as required by law.
